



U14 Scottish Cup

Rules:

Please note that the competition will operate under the National Competitions Regulations with the following exceptions.

- Games will be 8 minute periods with 3 minutes overtime where required.
- The Half time intervals will also be reduced to 7 minutes.

- Only 1 (one) timeout per half will be permitted.

- Zone defences are NOT permitted

- Teams must have a minimum of 10 players present and on the scoresheet, all of which must take part in the game.
 - There are no further restrictions on the amount of time any player can play - However, it is expected that all coaches give reasonable court time to all competitors and respect the score and basketballscotland code of conduct.

- Teams more than 15 points up cannot full court press – sag back to half court
- Teams more than 20 points up cannot full court press – sag back to outside the 3-point line
- Possession arrow remains in favour of any team down more than 10 points
- 24' Shot Clocks are only required for the semi finals however, if it is possible to supply them for earlier rounds you may use them.
 - The rule should still be applied by the referees with verbal warnings at 20' or 10' on a 14 second reset.
- Each round of the competition will have a play by date and this must be adhered to.
- For each round, the first named team is the home team and must offer 3 dates to the opposition.
- Where teams are more than 40 miles apart a minimum of two weekend dates must be offered.
 - Play by dates for rounds are as follows:
 - Last 32 = Last Sunday in October (where required)
 - Last 16 = Last Sunday in November
 - Quarter Finals = Last Sunday in January excluding Scottish Cup Finals where is scheduled in January.
 - Semi Finals = Last Sunday in February

- The Finals will take place on the weekend of the SBC Division 1 Play-Off Finals.

- Referee fees are £15.00 per official per game plus travel expenses and basketballscotland will appoint the referees.
