Purpose:	To lead development of Tiny Titans basketball and launch 'Girls Can' programme which meet the aims and objectives of North Lanarkshire Titans CIC

Main Duties & Responsibilities:

- Lead, develop and deliver Tiny Titans programme for 3yrs-5yrs age group and new 'Girls Can' programme.
- Provide fun, engaging, exciting classes for all participants.
- Responsibility for ensuring activities is planned and implemented safely according to the procedures of the Club relating to the running of all activities.
- To ensure that the venue, equipment, and all activities conform to the Club's minimum operating standards, making the safety of young people paramount (which includes health and safety, child protection and sport-specific guidance).
- To deliver activities as part of a planned, progressive programme linked to the principles of long-term athlete development plan (LTAD).
- To help recruit, retain children and young people in sport by providing guidance on opportunities to progress in the sport based on the individuals' interests and abilities.
- To inform the Club of any accidents/incidents which occur whilst working on the activity, and of any other concerns that arise, using appropriate procedures.
- To ensure all equipment associated with the coaching programme is correctly maintained, stored, used and returned promptly upon conclusion of the programme.
- To commit to a programme of Continuous Professional Development (CPD) to ensure that the coaching provided is of the highest quality.
- To adopt a fair and equitable approach to coaching at all times. This includes adapting sessions to cater for individuals with different ranges of ability regardless of age, gender, race, or disability.
- To agree to abide by the Club's Code of Conduct for Coaches.
- To undertake any other duties as required by Head of Basketball Development where appropriate to the nature and grade of the post.



Essential:

- The work can be in the evening and possibly school hours
- Teaching relevant age appropriate skills and movements
- To maintain high ethical standards in coaching/instructing, ensure they keep up to date with their knowledge, skills and qualifications and prepare all sessions in advance
- To undertake training appropriate to the role e.g., child protection training
- To attend club meetings and report on progress of classes
- To offer feedback to the Club
- Full Driver's License and access to own transport due to nature of the role and transporting equipment

Desirable:

- Understanding of child development
- Understand Mini Basketball development
- Ability to create session planning
- Computer literate

Qualifications:

- Level 1 - UK Basketball Licence or other relevant basketball licences that is equal to the standards of coaching
- Physical education certification, diploma, or degree
