## basketballscotland Minimum Operating Standards for Coaches

Coaches must –

- Be registered with **basketball**scotland.
- Hold Active **basketball**scotland Membership to be adequately Insured for Liability.
- Hold a PVG Application comes via the club. Coaches should contact the Club Safeguarding Officer or whoever is processing PVG applications. New coaches only need a PVG if they are going to be doing Regulated Work with children or protected adults and we will only process their PVG application if they are a **basketball**scotland member.
- Hold a safeguarding qualification this should be renewed every 3 years.

Within basketball sessions coaches should -

- Ensure there is at least one qualified coach at each session. At youth sessions there should be at least one qualified coach and one adult (18yrs or over).
- Know where to find the standard operating procedures and emergency action plan for their coaching environment. This may include ratios, equipment, clothing, hazards and safeguarding policy.
- Know where to find players contact details and medical information.
- Have a Coach : Player Ratio of at least 1:20.
- Adhere to Coaches Code of Conduct (see next page).
